# An Inventory of Some of St. Marcus' Art Treasures

(Note: Art pieces and their locations tend to change over time; here is where they can be found on the eve of the 150th anniversary)

### A. Sanctuary

- 1. Altar, pulpit, lectern: The Hann-Wangerin Co., Milwaukee, c. 1904, built originally for St. Jacobi Lutheran Church; yellow poplar, polychromed in 1997 by Marvin Ritchie
- 2. Pulpit canopy and communion rail: Mark Kant, the Janesville Furniture Co., 1997, designed to match the lost St. Jacobi canopy
- 3. Art glass windows: master designs: Heinrich Hofmann, Dresden, c. 1885. Adaptation and glass execution: Carl Reimann, Milwaukee, 1913
- 4. Black walnut processional cross: design and construction, Mark Jeske, c. 1992.
- 5. Baptismal font: design by Amanda Gerken Raabe; construction by Nathan Sebald, 2012
- 6. Hand-tied oriental rug at altar. Created by Iranian artists in India, 2012. Tabriz style, "Herati" design featuring a "cycle of life": caterpillars, plants, butterfly
- 7. Two altar icons, Ukraine; gifts of John and Phoebe Lawrenz. At left, Madonna and child; at right, Christ the Teacher.
- 8. Holy Spirit/Baptism banner above the font: crafted by Polly Belcher
