RESPONSIBILITIES / DUTIES TO ACHIEVE POSITION OBJECTIVE:

- A. Spiritual Expectations:
 - Model a Christ-like example both in and out of the classroom always representing our Savior and reflecting His love.
 - Attend worship services when our children sing at St. Marcus.
 - Be disciplined with personal Bible study, faculty Bible study and active membership in church.
- B. Professional Expectations:
 - Understand and support the mission of the church and school.
 - Understand and support the philosophies and purposes of the school and specifically the primary elementary program.
 - As a Christian primary educator, he/she has knowledge and understanding of spiritual, social, emotional, physical and intellectual development.
 - Provide instructional and non-instructional support to students, families, teachers and staff members.
 - Have a collaborative and cooperative relationship with the director of primary education.
 - Follow the guidelines set forth in organizational handbooks.
 - Exhibit a growth mindset and commit to professional development as outlined in his/her Professional Development Plan.
 - Attends mandatory staff trainings and meetings.
- C. Educational Expectations:
 - Plan and implement instruction following the St. Marcus curriculum contributing to the growth and development of children.
 - Use a variety of assessment tools and processes to monitor student learning and provide feedback to students and parents.
 - Complete quarterly progress reports for each student in the classroom.
 - Complete required parent/teacher conferences.



- Participate in outreach activities for the primary program and school that allow students to interact with the community and learn outside of the classroom.
- Build and nurture positive relationships with students and parents.
- Adhere to the teacher commitments in the St. Marcus Covenant.

D. Meet Expectations of St. Marcus Staff

- Exemplifies mission mindedness and prioritizes ministry involvement
- Demonstrates responsibility and professionalism towards job responsibilities
- Establishes, maintains and publishes daily schedule
- Weekday school hours are from 7:00 AM to 4:00 PM
- Be available by phone to staff members (and St. Marcus families when necessary) after school hours and on weekends
- Contribute to the school culture by supporting outreach activities (ie. quarterly awards ceremony)
