I WILL...

- do everything in my power to ensure the academic success of my students/my child (SL)
- arrive at school ready for learning before 8:00am looking neat and clean in uniform (RE)
- be ready for teaching/my child will be rested and ready to learn (RE)
- be accessible to support our families/communicate with my child's teacher when needed (SL)
- support the teachings of the Bible at St. Marcus/ and the Biblical foundations of St. Marcus (CF/BD)
- Create a classroom atmosphere that respects the rights of all students/ provide a quiet place in the home for my child to read learn and complete homework and make sure my child completes all work by reviewing and signing homework (RE)
- attend all necessary meetings including orientations and parent/teacher conferences (RE)
- Communicate information in a professional and timely manner/ notify the school in advance of any necessary absence (by 9:00am) (RE)

I understand that by failing to keep these commitments, the K3 Program Director and/or another administrator will discuss possible consequences for my lack of support which could include removal from the program.

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
